Subject goal Familiarizing students with the basic characteristics of public policies, as well as the method of analysis in the design and implementation of public policies, good practice, monitoring their implementation, checking their "health" and initiating change and improvement.		
Subject outcome Building capacities for the implementation of simple research, and organizing teams of professionals specialized in different areas of public policy in the field of sustainable development and environmental protection. Students will become familiar with the basic principles of communication of the results and conclusions of the analysis, as well as the proposal or idea for the actions that flow from them. Students will develop the ability to create and present analytical articles.		
Subject content <i>Theoretical classes</i> As a part of this course, the following topics will be covered: The notion of public policy, public policy and the importance of its content. Actors of public policy, objectives and instruments of public policy. The process of creating public policy (setting the daily political agenda, formulation, decision making and implementation, evaluation). Types of research and the most common quantitative and qualitative methods for data collection and analysis. Preparation of research, defining research questions and design of the research process. Data collection. Public Policy Analysis and methodological procedures (problem definition, policy design, monitoring and evaluation as a form of policy analysis). Creating high-quality analytical texts of different formats. Instant analysis. Advocating public policy. <i>Practical classes:</i> Theoretical classes will be constantly accompanied by practical work. A work will be interactive and participatory, with an emphasis on connecting the current life and professional experiences of students with new concepts and methods. In accordance with the basic objectives of the direction economy environment, emphasis will be placed on examples from the field of environmental protection and sustainable development, and particularly will be taken account of the establishment of a dialogue between the students and the exchange of experiences and perspectives of different sectors in which these two areas of influence (cross cutting issues). A series of interactive presentations, plenary discussions and group exercises on examples from the domain of environmental protection and sustainable development, will be followed by successive seminar paper on the topic of public policy in the election offer - a comparative analysis of the past (at least 3 local or republican, as student wants) elections in Serbia. In the framework of practical training there will be preparations carried out for an analysis of public policies in Serbia, which will be implemented through the second seminar, as an independent student's work.
