The subject outcome is in practical enabling of students to properly conceive, monitor and interpret complex decision making processes of ecological politics actors here and in the world in terms of the environment, and wider sustainable development as well as influence of ecological politics on creation of other state policies.

Instruments and principles of ecological politics. Goals of ecological politics. Understanding of ecological politics. Making difference between ecological politics and legal ecology. Strategic, planned and action documents of ecological politics of sovereign country. Ecological politics and the environment. Ecological politics and sustainable development. Ecological politics and DOP. The role of ecological movements. The role of international government organizations in ecological politics. Understanding the role of international non-governmental organizations in ecological politics – Greenpeace case study. The influence of international organizations of global character (UN and specialized agencies of UN). Ecological politics of the Republic of Serbia. Local ecological politics. Ecological politics in EU. Global ecological politics. Urban and rural ecological politics. Special overview of energetic politics of the RS and EU. Challenges of global ecological politics.			
<i>Practical classes:</i>			
Study research work about reach of ecological politics in the Republic of Serbia or EU. Debates about ecological-political topics significant for understanding subject of ecological politics. Audio-visual practice classes – presentation of multimedia forms with ecological-political content and their group interpretation. Professional talk with actors of ecological politics in the RS and on local level.
