<b>Subject goal</b>		
Ability to understand the situation in terms of taking and implementing of international agreements in terms of the environment, for the implementation of elements of international environmental law, as well as the contribution of the Republic of Serbia to its development in order to protect short-term and long-term oriented ecological interests. Familiarizing with the achievements (both local and global scene) for the purpose of democratic creation, development, synchronization and application of the basic elements and principles of environmental policy, particularly the principles and directives of the EU. Special attention is paid to international multilateral contracts in the field of the environment and elements of the corporate-company law and corporate social responsibility.		
<b>Subject outcome</b>		
Ability to protect the inalienable human right to a healthy environment as well as their own environment by working on the development and implementation of elements of international environmental law and policy, on two levels: - in the development of high-quality ecological legal relationship towards the subjects of international law, as well as all the subjects of international environmental law (country, legal entities as well as individuals); -and on the level of the Republic of Serbia, specifically the introduction of the application and its elements that we enter into our legislation through confirmation (ratification).		
<b>Subject content</b>		
<i>Theoretical classes</i>		
The study of the formation of permanent roads and ad hoc bodies and organizations, the necessary elements for the beginning of the creation of an international environmental law. The study of international organizations relevant to the legal treatment of environmental values, relations and environmental policy. Historical development of policy and law of EU in the field of environmental protection. EU institutions for creating and implementing policies and environmental law. The study of the principles of international environmental law, the study of the essential elements of international environmental law, particularly those of importance to R. of Serbia (analysis of the most important elements of international environmental law: over 60 conventions, a series of annexes, as well as a number of protocols). Series of classes devoted to the study of documents of international environmental law that could be significant for Serbia in the future, for which reason they can be ratified (close to 20 conventions). Lectures about roads, ways and levels of implementation of international environmental law in domestic legal reality. The strategy of EU legislation in the environmental field. Elements of corporate-company law and corporate social responsibility.		
<i>Practical classes</i>		
Workshops with thematic treatment of certain international conventions in the environmental protection, especially Aarhus and Basel, as well as others with transboundary environmental issues.
